How the policy of Plantation worked

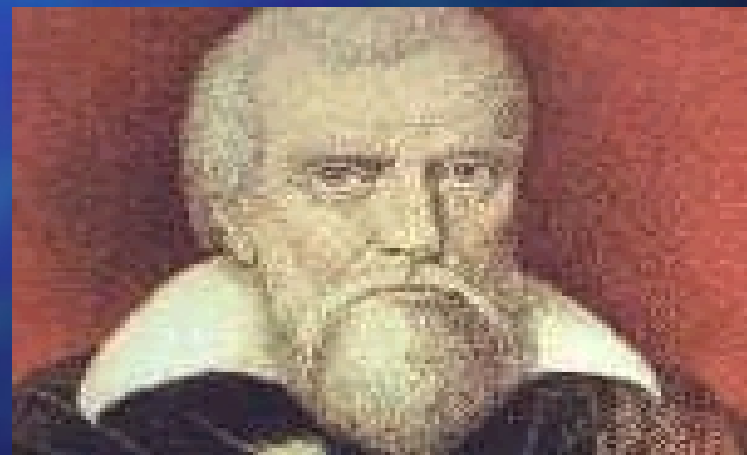
- The English confiscated the Irish land.

Results of the Ulster Plantation

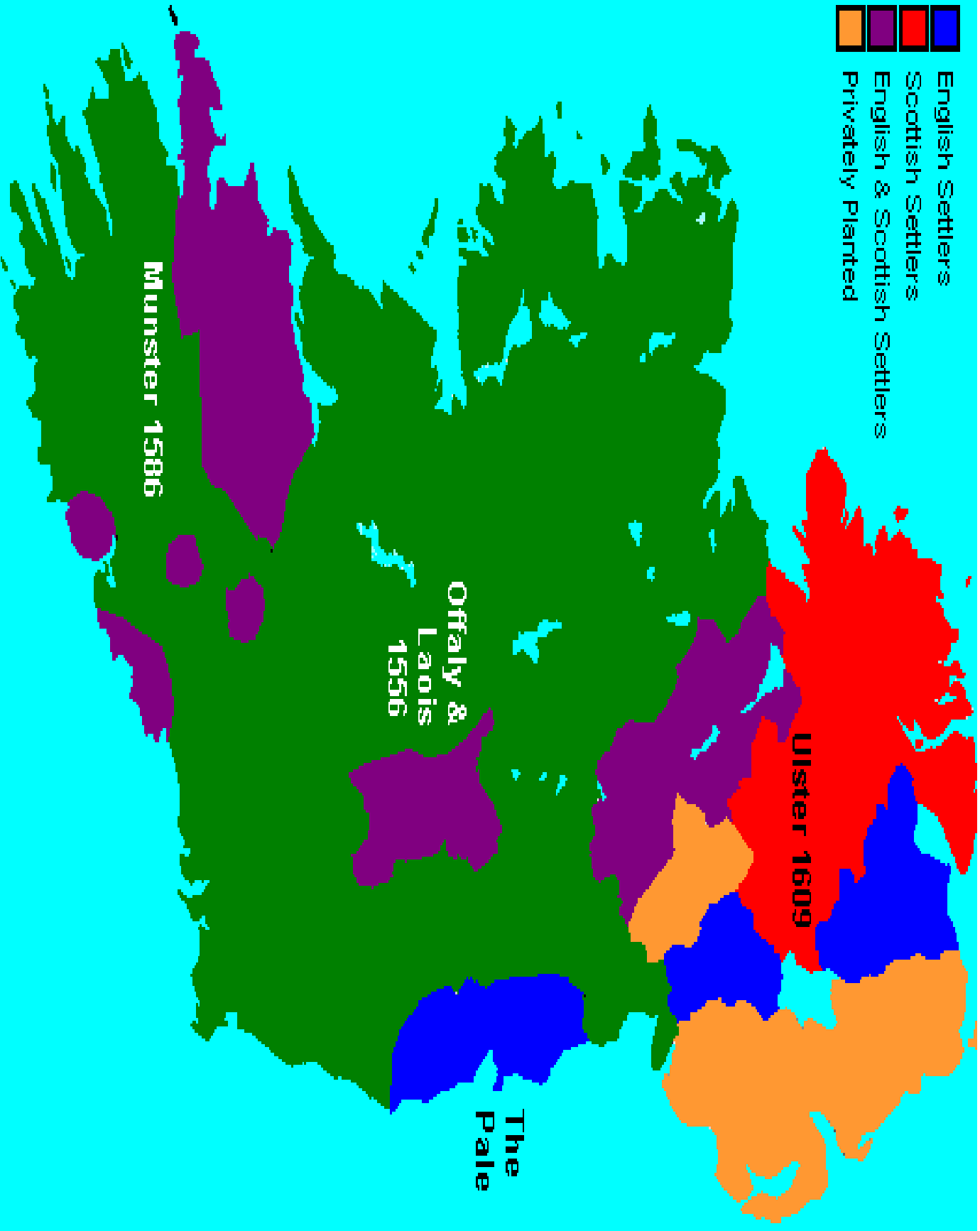
- Land and Religion- there was mistrust between the protestants planters and the loyal anglo-irish.
- The Economy- New farming methods were introduced and Ulster became wealthy.
- Towns- More than 20 new towns were built e.g. Derry, Strabane and Letterkenny.

- County Derry was given to the London Guilds to settle.
- The guilds built the city known to some as LondonDerry
